Prof. Chang will address the following two issues: one is the major achievements and challenges of contemporary Taiwanese historiography. In terms of the impact of digitalization projects, he'll introduce five major research and archival institutions in Taiwan and will conclude with some personal observation and reflection on the future challenges of Taiwan history from the perspective of a practicing historian.
