

# Visitor Visa for Employment Seeking Purpose

## REQUIREMENTS

- Application form: Go to website: <https://visawebapp.boca.gov.tw>. Fill out the application form online with your complete name (Surname, First Name Middle Name). Print it out and sign on the second page. Please make sure that the bar-code located on the lower right hand side of the application form is readable.
- Two colored passport-size photos: Place two (2) glossy, passport-size (45 mm in height and 35 mm in width) photos with a white background taken within the last six (6) months on the application form. Composite photos, selfies and altered photos will not be accepted. The applicant must face forward and look directly at the camera, with eyes open and clearly visible. A neutral expression (mouth closed) and natural skin tone are required. Applicants who are unable to close their mouths are excluded from this requirement. The photographs must have appropriate brightness and contrast.
- Passport: The passport must be valid for at least 6 months from the date of the applicant's entry and have blank pages. One photocopy of the passport bio page with the applicant's photo is required.
- Completed & signed "ROC EMPLOYMENT-SEEKING VISA APPLICATION CHECKLIST"

- Applicant must fulfill one of the 3 following conditions and provide the according proof:
  - Being employed and the average monthly salary within the past six (6) months is not less than \$ 47,971 NTD. Please provide Proof of employment & Proof of the average monthly wage or compensation for the past six (6) months.
  - Graduated from one of the world's top universities identified by the ROC Ministry of Education (please view the list at [https://depart.moe.edu.tw/ed2500/News\\_Content.aspx?n=0BC849A93049621E&sms=E0AA294AA6810C0B&s=A3C411918479C683](https://depart.moe.edu.tw/ed2500/News_Content.aspx?n=0BC849A93049621E&sms=E0AA294AA6810C0B&s=A3C411918479C683)), within the last one (1) year and are not yet employed. Presented with applicant's highest educational diploma and transcripts as proof.
  - Deemed otherwise eligible by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) after consultations with the central competent authority of the ROC (Taiwan) Government. Presented with a permit issued by the MOFA.

- Proof of sufficient financial resources (at least NT\$100,000 or equivalent)
- Evidence of health and comprehensive medical insurance for the entire duration of stay in the ROC (Taiwan)
- Proof of no criminal record issued by competent authorities of the applicant's country
  - (1) Documents should be issued within one (1) year at the time of the submission of the visa application to this office.
  - (2) For those with Philippine passports, documents issued in the Philippines (NBI) should be authenticated by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) and Taipei Economic and Cultural Office in the Philippines (TECO).
  - (3) Documents of no criminal records issued outside the Philippines should be authenticated by the R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission with consular district over the country where the documents were issued. If the documents are written in a language other than English, the accompanying Chinese- or English- translation of these documents is required and the translation must also be authenticated by the corresponding R.O.C. (Taiwan) overseas mission.
- PSA Birth Certificate (only for those with Philippine passports)
- PSA Marriage Certificate (required for married female applicants with Philippine passports)
- Other supporting documents
  - (1) Plan for seeking employment
  - (2) The applicant may be scheduled for an interview if required. Other additional documents may be required during processing.

## **NOTICES**

1. All documents submitted to this office must be original with one (1) set of photocopies on A4-sized paper and arranged in the order of the requirements listed above. Original documents are to be returned after review.
2. Visas are issued as stipulated by Article 12 of the Statute governing the issuance of ROC visas for foreign passports. As a sovereign nation, the ROC has the right to refuse visa applications without providing any explanation for such decisions; the visa application fee is not refundable.
