Introduction

Founded in March 1917, Chulalongkorn University is Thailand's first institution of higher learning. The groundwork and preparation for the university's establishment, however, took place almost half a century earlier. The worldwide economic, social and political changes in the late nineteenth century compelled Siam, as Thailand was officially called until 1939, to adapt in order to avoid Western colonization. King Chulalongkorn (Rama V) introduced a royal policy to strengthen and improve the government so that the country could successfully resist the tides of colonialism. One of the major parts of this policy was to improve the Siamese educational system to produce capable personnel to work in both the public and private sectors. To this end, a school was founded in 1871 at the Royal Pages Barracks within the Grand Palace compound. Then, in 1882, King Chulalongkorn upgraded the school and gave it the name "Suankularb". In the same year, the King also established other schools, including the Army Cadet School, the Cartographic School, the School for Princes and the School for Dhamma Studies.

This quote, taken from King Chulalongkorn's royal speech to members of the royal family and civil servants, is confirmation of His Majesty's belief in equal educational opportunity. The King granted the policy to set up schools throughout the kingdom, together with institutions of higher learning, and declared, "...education in our country must have the highest priority, which I am determined to develop."

In 1899, Prince Damrong Rajanupab, a younger brother of King Chulalongkorn and the Minister of Interior at the time, submitted a proposal to establish the Civil Service Training School, with Phraya Wisutsuriyasak (M.R. Pia Malakul — who later assumed the title of Chao Phraya Phrasadej Surendradhibodi) as the principal. However, since the students had to work as royal page trainees in their third year

of study before graduation, the name of the school was changed to the Royal Pages School in 1902. The Royal Pages School progressed steadily and produced an increasing number of graduates for the government each year. Recalling the original intention of his late father, King Chulalongkorn, to establish an institution of higher learning, King Vajiravudh (Rama VI) ordered that the Royal Pages School be elevated into an institution of higher education and named it The Civil Service College of King Chulalongkorn on January 1, 1911. In the beginning, the course of study focused on government. Eventually, the curriculum expanded to meet the needs of the kingdom and included more disciplines, such as law, international relations, commerce, agriculture, engineering, medicine, and teacher education.

The Civil Service College then used proceeds donated by members of the royal family, government officials and ordinary citizens to commission a statue of King Chulalongkorn the Great. Once completed, about 800,000 baht of the collected funds remained in the Royal Treasury Ministry. With interest, the sum accumulated and King Vajiravudh then gave it to the college, to be used as the original capital. Furthermore, he graciously donated the palace of his brother, the late Crown Prince Vajirunhis, as the site of the college and gave around 520 acres of the King's private land adjacent to the palace for the college's future expansion. Soon after, the Administration Building was constructed as the college's first building in January 1915.

After several years of operation, King Vajiravudh knew that the Civil Service College was now ready for its next transformation. On March 26, 1917, His Majesty declared that the college become Chulalongkorn University, in memory of his father. The newly founded university was under the supervision of the University Affairs Department, Ministry of Education, and Phraya Anukijwithoon was the first principal (the title was changed to Rector in 1935). There was a University Council, which was responsible for policy making, planning and advising on the affairs of the university. Prince Damrong Rajanupab was the Chairman of the Council, and the principal of the university was the Secretary.

When it was first founded, the university had 380 students, four faculties, and two campuses. The Faculty of Medicine was located at Siriraj Hospital, the Faculties of Public Administration and Engineering were housed in the Administration Building, and the Faculty of Arts and Science was in Prince Vajirunhis' palace in Patumwan district. The Law School was under the responsibility of the Ministry of Justice until the university was ready to take over, and the Teachers' Training School was handed over to the Ministry of Education.

In 1923, the university accepted high school graduates to study in the Faculty of Medicine and received support from the Rockefeller Foundation to organize a Bachelor's degree program in medicine. Five years later, the first group of 18 graduates completed their studies and were awarded the first medical degrees in the kingdom.

By 1929, the Faculty of Public Administration became the Faculty of Law and Political Science. In 1933, a year after the establishment of the constitutional monarchy, the government transferred the faculty to

Thammasat University, which was established in 1934. From 1934 to 1958, the university focused on the improvement of undergraduate education; thus, more faculties were established. In 1961, the university established the Graduate School followed by numerous research centers and institutes.

The history of Chulalongkorn University is one of transformation and development. This has not changed. Over the century, the university has continuously worked for excellence in education and research, befitting itself to the name of a beloved monarch, King Chulalongkorn the Great.

Introduction

Founded in June 7th, 1934, Maejo University (MJU) is considered Thailand's oldest agricultural institution. It was first established as the Northern Agricultural Teachers Training School under the Ministry of Education and was later transferred to the Ministry of Agriculture to become the Kasetsart Preparatory School. After a year, it was officially installed as Maejo Agricultural School to serve as a research station of Kasetsart University (KU), a state university in Bangkok. It began to accept M.6 (Grade 12) students who, upon finishing at Maejo, were automatically admitted to KU for a 4-year degree program.

In 1956, Maejo was renamed Chiang Mai College of Agriculture, making it the first certificate-granting agricultural college under the Ministry of Education. Its graduates became secondary school teachers in agriculture.

In 1975, Maejo was royally confirmed as a state university under the Ministry of University Affairs but was called the Institute of Agricultural Technology. With this status, however, it began to accept students from vocational schools to its 2-year programs (associate degree) and students from secondary schools to its 4-year degree programs. The aim of this was to give all vocational school graduates greater opportunity to attain higher education in agriculture. The 19th of February is thus celebrated as MJU's Foundation Day.

In 1982, the institute's name was again changed to Maejo Institute of Agricultural Technology upon the request of its alumni. However, due to its rapid development, it was elevated to full and complete university status on November 12th, 1996. It was given

the name Maejo University which was immediately approved by the national parliament.

Under the Ministry of Education, Maejo University is a degree-granting institute that educates students in practical agriculture in order to prepare them for agricultural pursuits. MJU strives to nurture and develop its graduates to become technically competent, scholarly, and culturally mature, thereby enabling them to contribute to the future of the country.

At present, Maejo University belongs to the Commission on Higher Education of the Ministry of Education.

Introduction

Prince of Songkla University (PSU), a public university established in 1967 as the first university in southern Thailand, consists of five campuses offering various programs of education consistent with the needs of their communities. Moreover, PSU also comprises 39 faculties, colleges and institutes, four hospitals, and more than 40 excellence and research centers, all committed to academic excellence, strong social responsibility, and active engagement in community services. The central aims of the university are to raise general education standards and support regional industry and

development. Introduction

Thammasat University was inaugurated on June 27, 1934. The original name of the University, as given by Professor Dr. Pridi Banomyong, was the University of Moral and Political Sciences. Professor Dr. Banomyong wished to establish a university to educate Thai people of democracy introduced to the nation for the first time two years earlier.

The philosophy of the University was marked after the speech of Professor Dr. Pridi Banomyong delivered before His Majesty the King's Regent as follow:

“..... A university is, figuratively, an oasis that quenches the thirst of those who are in pursuit of knowledge. The opportunity to acquire higher education rightly belong to every citizen under the principle of freedom of education.....”

True to the ideas of Professor Dr. Banomyong, the University of Moral and Political Sciences quickly became an open university that accepted everyone with a high school diploma and working people in general. No entrance examination was required, while tuition fee was minimal and textbooks were inexpensive. As the first open university in Thailand, students were not required to attend classes every day, but to take final examination to assess their progress. In the first year, 7,094 students

applied to attend the University, mostly from working - class families. At that time, only two programs were offered---Moral Science and Accountancy degree programs.

The coup d'tat on November 8, 1947 had a dramatic effect on the University. Soon after, the University's name was changed to Thammasat University (TU), and the open university system was abandoned, with four new degree programs being introduced-- Law, Political Science, Economics, and Commerce and Accountancy. Thammasat University Act of 2495 B.E. mandated that each program offer its own degree.

Echoing student unrest and a global push for a new era of freedom, Thammasat University became the center of student uprising in October 1973, with the demand for a new constitution and a parliamentary government.

His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej appointed Thammasat's then rector Professor Sanya Dharmasakti as the new Prime Minister during this time of crisis. Thammasat University continued to play a key role in changes and development of democracy and politics in Thailand.

In 1975, Professor Dr. Puey Ungpakorn, then rector of Thammasat University, realized that moving the country forward would depend on increasing focus on science and technology. Given such vision, he then set out to expand science and technology degree programs alongside with establishment of a new campus in Rangsit to relieve the crowded Taprachan campus. After contacting the Industrial Estates of the Ministry of Industry, Thammasat acquired 972 acres for expanding the University to Rangsit Campus, and since then development there has continued well until the present.

More development came in 1994, when Thammasat University launched another regional campus by developing land around Chonburi-Rayong Road, Bang Lamung District, Pong Sub-District, Chonburi Province. This became the home of the Thammasat University Pattaya Campus, dedicated to teaching, learning and research in technology and industrial development. The fortuitous choice worked well for this mission, as Chonburi was already a highly industrialized area.

More changes came on December 20, 2004 when Thammasat University continued its development in Pattaya with the launch of Pattaya Learning Resort to provide greater educational opportunities to the Thai people of Eastern Thailand. Today, bachelor degree programs in automotive engineering and software engineering are offered at Pattaya Campus as part of the University's long-term endeavor to establish the Campus as prime educational center of science and technology to cater for the growing industrial economy in the Eastern part of the country. Also central to the strategic plan is a long-term effort to achieve sustainable development and make Thammasat Pattaya a truly "Green Campus."

In Northern Thailand, Thammasat again responded to rapid demands of young people for quality higher-level education. With the establishment of the Lampang Campus on July 8, 1996, students from the Northern

part of Thailand no longer had to study far away from their home, but could enjoy the strengths of Thammasat University Lampang Campus community.

The first lecture class at Lampang Campus was held in 1998, with the School of Social Administration being the first to be introduced. The Lampang Campus later expanded to include other curricula, including bachelor's degree programs in law, social administration, fine applied arts, interdisciplinary studies, public health and sciences and technology with all degree programs adhering to the same rigorous academic standards practiced at Thammasat University main campus in Bangkok.

In 2011, Bangkok and nearby areas were hit with one of the worst floods in the history of Thailand. The Rangsit campus of Thammasat University rose to the occasion, providing temporary shelter to serve the people who lived nearby and were left without food and shelter by the devastation. More than 8,000 people volunteered to give away food, medicine and survival bags to the people from Patumthani and other nearby provinces, showing Thammasat University's true spirit. Thammasat's goal of guiding students to the highest standards of ethics and community services remained true, as they came together to serve the society in times of need – giving truth to the motto, “I love Thammasat because Thammasat teaches me to love the people.”

Amidst rapid changes in the world, Thammasat University, therefore, must adjust its learning and teaching pattern and develop the “Active Learning” approach of education.
